During the academic year 2004-2005, the first meeting of IQAC was held on 2nd August 2004. In this meeting, IQAC was established formally .In the meeting a discussion was held about NAAC peer team visit and the recommendations made by the committee. The discussion was also held on the subjects of continuation of NAAC work with the purpose of developing the quality of NAAC work. It was decided to carry out different academic, administrative and infrastructural activities as per the plan of action were worked out as follows:

#### I. The academic activities:-

In the first meeting of IQAC, it was decided to carry out all academic activities within the given time limit successfully. These activities included:

- 8) Organizing different contests of academic nature e.g. essay writing, debating, and elocution.
- 9) Conducting internal terminal examination for S.Y. / T.Y. B.A. Classes.
